Would / Used to / Will



Sentence Building



We use the modal verb 'will' to talk about what will happen in the future.

subject	modal verb	verb	place	time
Sara	will	go	to the mountains	next summer.

We use the modal verb 'would' to talk about what $\underline{\text{used to happen in the past}}$.

subject	modal verb	verb	object
Sara	would	learn about	the natural world.

'Used to' is not a modal verb, but it also helps to add meaning to verbs. It also means something happened <u>before now</u>.

subject	used to	verb	place	time
Sara	used to	go	to the mountains	every summer.



Sara Used to Go to the Mountains



(verse) Sara used to go to the mountains every summer.

She would play with her friends.

She would learn all about nature and the natural world. x2

(chorus) But she can't go this year.

She has to go to summer camp. x2

repeat verse repeat chorus

But she will go back next year.

She will go back again. x2
